

Justification for proposed fee from the years 2012-2013 to 2014-2015

- The Institute is one of the oldest Polytechnics in Western Maharashtra. The Diploma courses in Civil / Mechanical / Electrical & Electronics & Telecommunication Engineering receive Grant-in-Aid from Govt. of Maharashtra . These courses are accredited by National Board of Accreditation, AICTE, New Delhi, for a period of five years.
All admissions for Aided as well as Unaided Diploma courses are affected by the Director of Technical Education M.S.through Centralize Admission Process. Even for Un-aided courses 100% admissions are filled through centralized admission process by D.T.E. M.S.Mumbai
- The fee structure was revised by Shikshan Shulka Samiti in 27 June 2012 for the year 2012-13 and the fee was revised to Rs. 47090/- per student. Due to this increase , the Institute is in a position to appoint more teaching and non teaching staff and more appointments will be made in this year.
- The Institute has well-equipped laboratories and adequate infrastructure of the existing grant in aid courses.. Till date , the Institute has added equipments worth about Rs. 320.35 lacs for Un-Aided Diploma courses .
- The Institute proposes to add equipments worth Rs. 25 to 30 lacs every year for better academic facilities. It may be noted that in the year 2012-2013, the Institute has added equipments worth Rs. 30.85 lacs in various departments. **This aspect may please be considered for fixation of development fees.**
- As the expenses on account of salary, VI pay arrears operating and consumable expenses, Internet charges are likely to increase, the Institute estimates a fee of Rs. 46400 for the year 2013-14.
At present all faculty and staff members are paid salary as per sixth pay commission / AICTE norms . The payment of salary as per sixth pay commission and the arrears thereof are considered while proposing the fee structure for next three years.
- **The Institute has not paid Building rent to Modern Education society Pune for the current year 2012-2013 due to shortage of funds the rent will be paid During 2013-14 . As the Un-aided courses are offered in the building which are constructed from 1938 to 1991. Repairs and maintenance of buildings is frequently required . As such ,we propose that a rent of Rs. 3000/- per student per year may be approved while fixation of fees , as the institute does not claim depreciation on building cost.**
