

### Justification for proposed fee from the years 2012-2013 to 2014-2015


- The Institute is one of the oldest Polytechnics in Western Maharashtra. The Diploma courses in Civil / Mechanical / Electrical & Electronics & Telecommunication Engineering receive Grant-in-Aid from Govt. of Maharashtra . These courses are accredited by National Board of Accreditation, AICTE, New Delhi, for a period of five years.

**All admissions for Aided as well as Unaided Diploma courses are effected by the Director of Technical Education M.S.through Centralized Admission Process. Even for Un-aided courses 100% admissions are filled through centralized admission process by D.T.E. M.S.Mumbai**

- The fee structure was revised by Shikshan Shulka Samiti in 26 June 2013 for the year 2013-14 and the fee was revised to Rs. 45700/- per student. Due to this increase , the Institute is in a position to appoint more teaching and non teaching staff and more appointments will be made in this year.
- The Institute has well equipped laboratories and adequate infrastructure of the existing grant in aid courses. The Institute proposes to add equipments worth Rs. 25 to 30 lacs every year for better academic facilities. It may be noted that in the year 2013-2014, the Institute has added equipments worth Rs. 12.20 lacs in various departments. **This aspect may please be considered for fixation of development fees.**
- As the expenses on account of salary, VI pay arrears, operating and consumable expenses, Internet charges are likely to increase, the Institute estimates a fee of Rs. 54700 for the year 2014-15.

**At present all faculty and staff members are paid salary as per sixth pay commission / AICTE norms . The payment of salary as per sixth pay commission and the arrears thereof are considered while proposing the fee structure for next three years.**
